He went on to expand his legal career, becoming a trained mediator concentrating on contracting and negotiations, and serving as an Arbitrator with the New York City Court, Small Claims Division. In 2007, Mike transitioned into hospital management utilizing his training as a pharmacist. He became a pharmacy leader with New York-Presbyterian Hospital and then served as Director of Pharmacy for Joe DiMaggio Children’s Hospital, a part of the Memorial Health System. Mike went on to serve as the enterprise Vice-President of Pharmacy Services for Cancer Treatment Centers of America. He was the corporation’s key resource in assisting to reduce costs, enhance revenues, and utilizing data to support strategic business decisions.

Currently Mike is a Partner and founding member of the Florida Probate Law Firm, PLLC, which provides formal probate administration, ancillary probate administration, probate litigation, and professional executor services in all 67 counties across the state of Florida. He is also an Arbitrator with FINRA, the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, which handles arbitration cases on behalf of investors against financial brokerage firms.
