The 25th Stonewall Pride Parade and Street Festival in the City of Wilton Manors
Announced for Saturday, June 14, 2025

Wilton Manors, FL - The 2025 Stonewall Pride Parade and Street Festival in the City of Wilton Manors will be bigger than ever on Saturday, June 14, 2025. To commemorate the 25th anniversary of the event, expect more attendees, new vendors, the return of the Glow Night Parade, and lots of fun. The Street Festival along Wilton Drive will kick off at 3 p.m. with live music and multiple vendors followed by the Glow Night Parade at 8 p.m. Corporations, local businesses, and non-profits are all invited to participate in the one-day event that will end at 11p.m.

“The Stonewall Pride Parade and Street Festival is one of our signature events,” said Mayor Scott Newton. “I am proud that Wilton Manors is a place where everyone feels welcome and can come together from all over the state, country, and globe in celebration of Pride and the LGBTQ+ community.”

In previous years the event has attracted approximately 55,000 spectators and had a direct economic impact of more than \$20 million for Broward County, according to an independent study.
